## SUMMER 2022 CSU EXTENSION INTERNSHIP: MODERN MUSIC CREATION WITH AT-RISK YOUTH: CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND TEACHING WITH COLORADO MUSIC BRIDGE AND 4H

### DESCRIPTION

Colorado Music Bridge (CMB) is a nonprofit dedicated to mentoring young professional musicians to learn the art of teaching modern music to youth. Since our inception in 2020, CMB has been developing inclusive curricula with UDLM and Neurosequential Learning models at the core of our approach. 4H is a national nonprofit that offers at-home learning resources for kids focusing on science, healthy living and civic engagement, and works with at-risk youth in Colorado cities. This internship will provide a CSU student the opportunity to teach in outreach programs and partner with 4H agents and CMB directors to create a curriculum that adapts CMB's inclusive, modern music approach to a 4H model.

### OBJECTIVES

- Learn to utilize and teach with modern music creation technology (digital audio workstation, online software, MIDI keyboards and trigger interfaces)
- Receive feedback and coaching from Dr. Peter Stoltzman (DMA, Music and Human Learning)
- Receive financial mentorship from CMB directors (how to start an LLC, business bank account, write off expenses, etc.)
- Teach multiple weekly programs in Denver and/or Fort Collins
- Implement inclusive modern music creation curricula in outreach youth programs
- Work with 4H mentor(s) and CMB directors to tailor curriculum to 4H specs

### PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Prior experience teaching music to youth.
- Enthusiasm for nonprofit work with at-risk youth..
- Ability to self-direct and manage time--we need someone who will contribute ideas and show up for teaching and meetings reliably.
- Working toward completion of Bachelor's degree in Music or Education, with an openness to teaching popular music and using technology in the classroom.
- Reliable transportation is required for driving to and from Denver/Fort Collins.
